

Janet Coles fires 67 to erase Century club mark

SCOTTSDALE — Janet Coles, an Arizona State University freshman from Altos, Calif., set a women's course record of 67 yesterday in opening round of the Sun Devil Invitational women's golf tournament at Century Country Club.

Janet collected seven birdies and had no bogeys in posting a score that was seven under a women's par at the course.

Janet's great round and Mary Bea Porter's 76 put Arizona State into the team

lead with 143 going into today's final round. Next best were University of Arizona's Gail Runke-Paula Eger, 165, and Cal State at San Diego's Nancy Elliott-Susan Fleury, 182.

Miss Runke was third individually with 81, while Miss Eger and Christy Brandt, ASU, were next lowest at 84.
