

Janet Coles Is Medalist With 75

PINEHURST, N.C.- Eighteen year old Janet Coles of Aptos, the 1972 Northern California champion, fired a one over par 75 for medalist honors Monday in the 71st annual North and South Women's Amateur golf championship.

The former Watsonville High golfer registered five birdies in her round of 36-39 on the par 37-37 number two course at Pinehurst Country Club.

Last year, Miss Coles lost to Curtis Cupper Lancy Smith of Snider, N.Y.

Close to 60 golfers from around the nation competed for the 32-player field which will feature one round today, two rounds Wednesday and single rounds on Thursday and Friday.

Other scores on Monday included Mrs. Judith Oliver of Pittsburgh and Pat O'Brien of Pittsfield, Mass. both at 76.

Mrs. Jane Bastenchury Booth from Whittier is the defending champion of the week long tournament.

Miss Coles was to have met Dorothy Germain of Pleasant Gardens, N.Y. in her first round match today. Miss Germain qualified with an 81.
