

# Aptos' Janet Coles Advances

PINEHURST, N.C.—In second round play, Janet Coles defeated Carol Bowman of Peachtree City, Ga. 2 and 1 Wednesday morning in the North and South Amateur Golf Championships.

PINEHURST, N.C.—Despite erratic tee shots, Aptos' Janet Coles advanced to today's double round schedule of the North and South Amateur Golf Championships.

Steady putting sparked Miss Coles to a 4 and 3 victory to eliminate Dorothy Germain of Pleasant Garden, N.Y.

Mrs. Jane Booth launched a spectacular defense of her title with an impressive 5 and 3 win over Nancy Hager, finishing with a hole-in-one.

The 25-year old junior high school teacher was four under par for the 15 holes played over the No. 2 course of the Pinehurst Country Club.

Mrs. Booth started a run of five winning holes, three with birdies, by taking the eighth and was six-up through the 12th. Then Miss Hager, from Dallas, took the next two holes to cut the margin to four.

On the 154-yard 15th, Mrs. Booth banged a No. 4 iron tee shot onto the green and it bounced twice and into the cup for a match-ending hole-in-one.

There were no major upsets

on Tuesday as Mrs. Booth's Curtis Cup teammates of last year, Beth Barry and Lancy Smith along with two-time champion Mrs. Nancy Roth Syms led the way into today's double round.

Miss Barry was one under par in a 6 and 5 rout of Alice Wood of Decatur, Ga. while Miss Smith, from Snyder, N.Y. rallied from three down at the 11th tee to slip past Carol Semple of Sewickley, Pa., one up.

Mrs. Syms, from Colorado Springs, Colo., was even par in a 6 and 5 win over Helen Duntz of Claverack, N.Y.

A mild surprise came in the 4 and 3 victory fashioned by the steady putting Janice Krua of Binghamton, N.Y. over Janet Aulisi of West Caldwell, N.J.

Other first round matches included Connie Day of Cleveland, Tenn., edging Ers. D.K. Holman of Annandale, Va., 2-up, Debbie Eassey from

Bethlehem, Pa. topped Mrs. Evelyn Grant of Bangor, Maine, 4 and 3, and Cynthia

Booker of Clarkston, Mich., scored a 4 and 2 win over April Bain of Williamsdale, N.Y.
