

Coles leads after 1st round of LPGA event

^N YOSHIKAWA, Japan (AP) — American rookie pro golfer Janet Coles fired a four-under-par 70 and took the first-round lead Tuesday in the \$100,000 Mizuno Classic on the Ladies Professional Golf Association tour.

A field of 69 women golfers, including 53 foreigners teed off for the first prize money of \$15,000 dollars at the 5,754-yard, par-74 Hanayashiki golf course near Kobe in Western Japan.

The 23-year-old Coles, who turned pro in February, shot 36-34.

Two strokes behind in second place were Beth Stone of Miami and Debbie Massey, also of the United States, with 72.
