### Coles keeps lead despite bad hole

Janet Coles, seeking her second professional victory, carded a triple bogey but managed to hold on to a one-stroke lead over Nancy Lopez after three rounds of the LPGA Elizabeth Arden Golf Classic at North Miami Beach, Fla.

Coles shot a 1-over-par 73 despite the triple bogey on the par 4, 335-yard 17th hole. Her three-day total is a 5-under-par 211.

Lopez, who fired a 2-under 70, was alone at 212, followed by Stephanie Farwig at 213 and Sandra Spuzich at 214. Farwig, who finished in a tie for 26th in last and sixth-ranked by the WBC, knocked Baret down with a flurry of punches capped by two overhand rights to the jaw. Baret was kneeling when referee Arthur Mercante reached the 10-count ending the scheduled 10-round bout.

Baret, ranked 14th by the WBC, suffered his first loss after a 16-0 start with 15 knockouts.

week's Mazda Classic of Deer Creek, carded a 6-under 68 for the low round of the day. The 66 was Farwig's best round since she earned her LPGA Tour card in July 1982.
