

The annual Janet Coles pro-am, scheduled for Sept. 26 at Pajaro Valley Golf Course, is expected to be backed this year by a major sponsor, which is to kick in \$17,000 to cover the appearance fees of 17 LPGA players who are to join Coles. Contracts have been drawn up, and the tournament committee is waiting for the signed agreements to be returned.

The tournament, a benefit for the Watsonville High Foundation, is to expand to an 18-team field this year, with four amateurs playing with each pro, to raise money for Coles' alma mater. Coles, the 1972 WHS grad who is having a solid year on the LPGA Tour, donates her time in helping coordinate the tournament, and appears to have it headed toward becoming one of the top pro-am events in the area. Play is limited to 72 amateur players, with the entry fee is \$250 to support the foundation.
